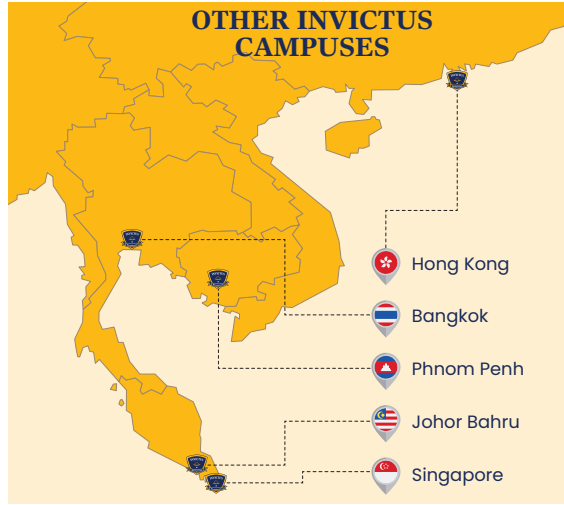

OUR CAMPUSES

TSEUNG KWAN O (KINDERGARTEN & PRIMARY)

Our Tseung Kwan O waterfront location puts our kindergarten and primary sections at the heart of a growing international community popular with young families. The modern campus houses classrooms and learning spaces which have been designed to promote learning and personal growth. The indoor hall, library, and multi-purpose rooms for music and arts activities, are used by children in all year levels. Nearby government sports facilities are used weekly for Physical Education and Extra-Curricular Activities. Many students arrive at school on foot, or by bike or scooter, and a network of school bus routes brings students in from other areas of Hong Kong, Kowloon, and the New Territories.





OUR CAMPUSES

CHAI WAN (SECONDARY)

Located at the foot of Mount Parker, our Secondary Campus sits in the eastern district of Chai Wan. Repurposing 3 levels of the former Hing Man Shopping Complex, students are given a proper secondary school environment with classrooms, independent study rooms, 2 state-of-the-art science labs and an art & design studio. Our campus is fitted with Wi-Fi throughout our school and each student can easily connect their own devices to collaborate together in the classroom. Our secondary classes has a maximum 1:25 teacher-to-student ratio

Our multi-purpose hall is used for various activities including: all-school performances, special presentations, examinations, our weekly assemblies, and much more. Our library provides students a quiet environment for focus and concentration. Our feature tree on L4 brings a vibrancy and freshness into our campus. Two covered areas on L4 and L6 provide students with spaces to socialize with one another while taking in fresh air and natural light.

We are surrounded by many outdoor government facilities, giving our students the chance to partake in different sporting activities in class and during break times. The campus is easily accessible by public transportation and drops our students off right at our doorstep. School bus service is available to-and-from certain parts of Hong Kong, in more populated areas where our students reside.

KINDERGARTEN CURRICULUM (TKO)

Invictus Kindergarten is a bilingual school offering International Early Years Curriculum (IEYC). IEYC has a clear process of learning that is focused on personal, development and international mindedness. Through holistic enquiry and play-based approaches, it provides a valuable foundation for students beginning their learning journey.

In addition to IEYC, Invictus Kindergarten uses a HK-based Chinese Language Curriculum (traditional character), an adapted Early Years Foundation Stage programme for our English, and the Singapore Ministry of Education Mathematics Framework, a comprehensive and world-renowned programme.

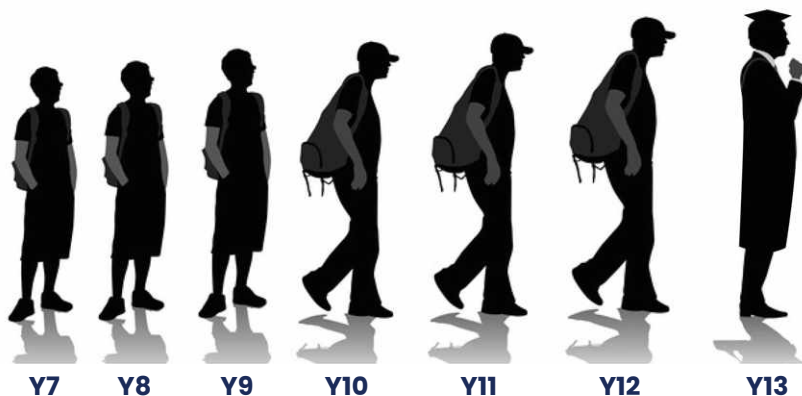

PRIMARY

PRIMARY CURRICULUM (TKO)

In the primary years (Y1-Y6) students are immersed in a bilingual programme using English and Chinese (traditional written characters). The programme utilises modern and innovative teaching methods to develop skills and knowledge in curricular areas, as well as to develop personal growth in areas such as resilience, collaboration, and international mindedness. The Chinese language programme is adapted and based upon the HK Chinese Language Curriculum and the Mathematics programme uses the Singapore Mathematics Framework. For English and other subject areas, the International Primary Curriculum (IPC) provides a broad and holistic curriculum, complemented, by the Cambridge Primary programme, to ensure that all teaching and learning at Invictus is tailored to the needs of our students.



SECONDARY

SECONDARY CURRICULUM *(Chai Wan)*

At our secondary levels, we offer Cambridge Lower Secondary, Cambridge IGCSE, Cambridge International AS & A-Level curricula. Year 7 to 9 students will build their foundation for success on Cambridge Lower Secondary curriculum before moving on to undertake their examinations for the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE). To fully prepare them for university, our students will have the opportunity to pursue the Cambridge International A-Levels (Advanced Level) during their Year 12 & 13 years in the subjects relevant to their future university studies and of their interests. Through following the Cambridge Pathway, we aim to build our students into confident, responsible, reflective, innovative, and engaged young adults of high character.



SCHOOL LIFE IN INVICTUS

Invictus offers holistic education through **in-class learning, field trips, school celebrations, physical education & Extra Curriculum Activities (ECA)**, providing our students with opportunities to develop their personal values and social skills beyond the classroom. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

STEP 1



Submit an Application

Submit an online application form to enter our applicant pool with the required documents listed below:

Copy of Child Birth Cert

Copy of HKID or Passport + Valid Visa

Copy of Child's Passport

Recent Passport Photo of Child

Copy of HKID of Parent or Passport + Valid Visa

STEP 2



Admission Assessment

All admissions to Invictus International School are subject to an in-person assessment. The Kindergarten and Primary assessments are generally done in small groups to ensure children can work well together. The Secondary assessment is a written test to gauge the student's level in Mathematics and English. For Y9-Y12 applicants, potential students will sit a CAT4 assessment to assess their cognitive abilities.

STEP 3



Offer of Admission and Contract

Upon successful application and acceptance, you will receive the following documents:

- Formal offer letter of enrolment
- Invictus International School's Terms and Conditions
- Invictus International School's Tuition Fees, Schedule, and Payment Instructions

Parents shall review the documents and return the signed Offer Letter within 2 weeks of issue. An invoice for the first month's tuition will be sent out upon receipt of the signed Offer Letter. Invoice must be settled within 3 weeks from Offer Letter issue date to secure the child's slot for the allotted term.

STEP 4



Required Enrolment Documents

An enrolment pack will be issued prior to the child's first day at Invictus. These enrolment documents must be completed prior to the start of school:

- Direct Debit Authorization Form
- Photo Release Consent Form
- Invictus Medical Form (to be completed by a doctor)
- Signed Terms and Conditions
- Pick up card Form
- Immunization Records
- Address Proof
